HVAC Scope of work:

- New HVAC in new gym lobby, hallway, and weight room
- New HVAC in old gym (Gym will be air conditioned)
- Replace existing HVAC in shop
- Replace existing HVAC in 1st,2nd,3rd, 4th grade classrooms
- New HVAC in 1st,2nd,3rd, 4th grade hallway
- Replace existing HVAC in board room and superintendent's office
- Replace HVAC in cafeteria (existing cooling only, will add heat as well)
- New HVAC in office near cafeteria
- Replace existing HVAC in High School
- •New HVAC in H.S. hallway and locker area
- New cooling only unit in server room in H.S.
- Exhaust fans in all restrooms & locker rooms
- Existing boiler will be eliminated and replaced with energy efficient HVAC
- Demo boiler and convert room into classroom or office space

Roof Scope of work:

• New roof on new gym lobby area, old gym, PreK/5th grade, teacher work room, cafeteria area, entire high school, stage and shop

Light Scope of work:

• New LED's in entire district (We currently have fluorescent lighting)

General Construction Scope of work:

- Upgrade partitions and fixtures in new gym lobby restrooms
- Replace all exterior doors (District will also install controlled access security)
- Frame in window and door in board room (have one door and window)
- Enclose exterior doors in kindergarten room
- Convert weight room to special education room
- Convert work room near cafeteria to classroom
- Convert boiler room to teacher workroom
- Remove/Demo/Sell modular classrooms (Relocate classrooms into existing high school)
- Remodel existing classrooms
- Level ground underneath modular and build carport for school vehicles
- Convert existing pole barn into weight room/locker room/ community fitness center
- Tuck point exterior masonry on entire district
- Paving in parking lot
- Abate Asbestos
- New security camera system with remote access

Supplementary Project:
